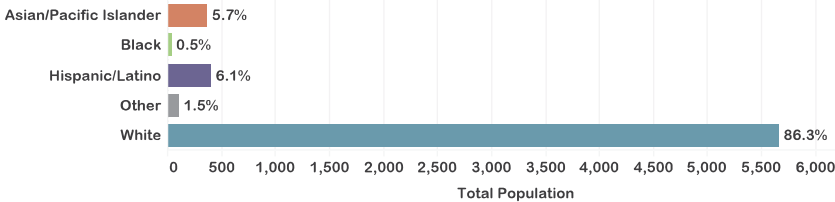

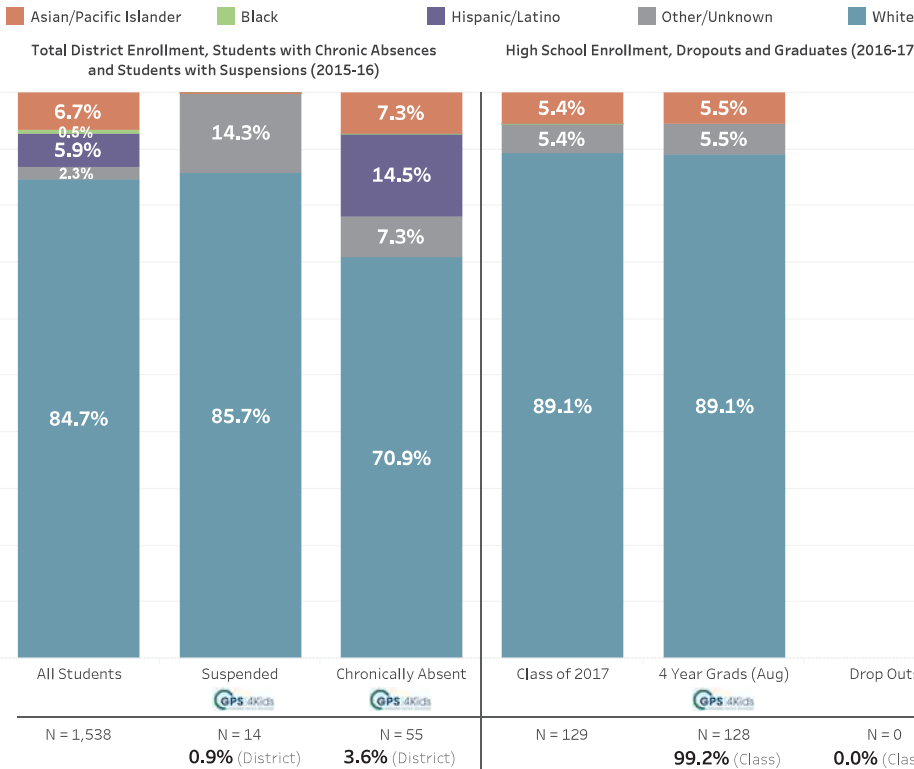

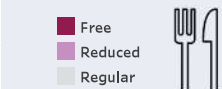
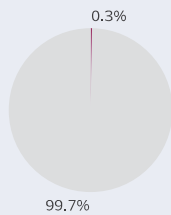

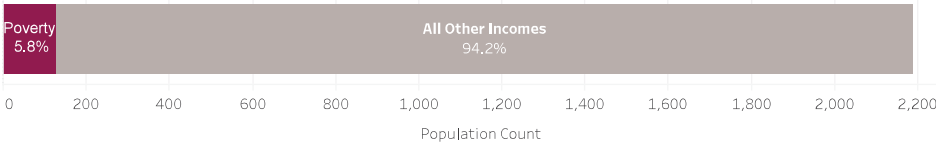
#### Percent of Students with Free/Reduced Lunch (2016-17)



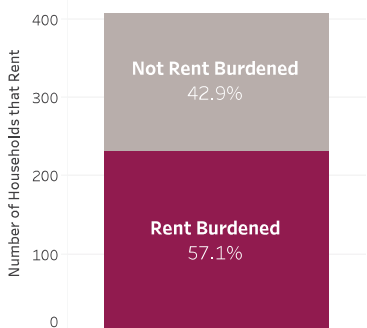
