

# **FINANCIAL PROFILE FOR 2018**



In 2018, there was a shortfall of revenues to expenses in the amount of \$226,575. WCA has unaudited net assets (assets minus liabilities) of \$2,758,416 and unrestricted assets of \$719,623.

2018 has been a busy and productive year. We said goodbye to longtime Executive Director Cora Greenberg and welcomed veteran WCA staffer Allison Lake to lead our organization. We hosted our first full day advocacy breakfast and conference, Vision 0 to 3, informing partners of potential advocacy opportunities to drive positive outcomes for babies and toddlers during those critical first 1000 days of life. 
