GETTING READY FOR ELECTION DAY

Qualifications to Register to Vote

In order to able to register to vote, you must:

- Be a U.S. Citizen
- Be 16 years old for early registration, and be 18 years old to register and actively vote.
- Be a resident of New York State and a county, city or village for at least 30 days before the election
- Not be in prison or on parole for a felony conviction (unless pardoned or restored rights of citizenship)
- Not be deemed mentally incompetent by a court
- Not be registered to vote elsewhere

You will need to fill out a **voter registration form** that is available in English and Spanish and submit it through one of the methods listed below. The forms also allow you to change your name and/or address, enroll in a political party, and change your enrollment. For more info > <u>citizenparticipation.westchestergov.com/register-to-vote</u>

Information to Consider Before You Register

Before you register to vote, decide whether you want to belong to a political party or be an independent voter.

- Political parties allow you to participate in primary elections to select their candidate(s) if you register with them.
- Independent voters cannot participate in primary elections because they are non-partisan and therefore do not associate themselves to one political party over the other preferring to vote based on values about issues.

Deadlines that are important to know for <u>county elections</u> and <u>general elections</u> are listed on this website.

Great resources to compare where candidates stand on issues include surveys such as <u>WCA's annual</u> <u>candidate survey</u>.

Register In-Person

- Westchester County Board of Elections , 25 Quarropas Street, White Plains, NY 10601
- Any Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) Office
- Any of 15 New York State agencies such as the Westchester County Department of Social Services (DSS) : <u>www.elections.ny.gov/NVRA.html</u>

Requires ONE of the following documents:

- NYS driver license, permit, or non-driver ID card
- Social security number
- Or, another form of identifying document stated at the top of the Voter Registration Form

Register by Mail

Mail your registration form to the Westchester County Board of Elections, 25 Quarropas Street, White Plains, NY 10601 with one (1) of the following documents:

- NYS driver license, permit, or non-driver ID card
- Social security number card
- Or, another form of identifying document stated at the top of the <u>Voter Registration Form</u>.

Register Online

Requires ALL of the following documents:

- 1. NYS driver license, permit, or non-driver ID card
- 2. ZIP Code currently on record with the New York State Department of Motor Vehicles
- 3. Social security number card
