and Tarrytown to be civically engaged and involved in progress in their communities.

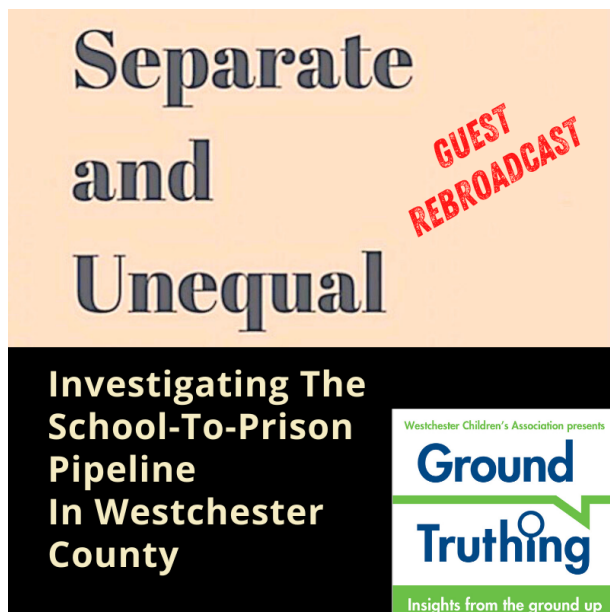
