A CENTURY OF ADVOCACY

2010s

- Led a successful campaign to make children a top priority for government spending, thus preserving more than \$7 million in county-funded children and youth services.
- Convenes an inter-agency Home Visiting Workgroup to expand early childhood home visiting programs to help new parents improve their parenting skills and connect to community resources.
- Published *Dreams Deferred: Reconnecting Youth to School, Work, and Community*, a study of factors affecting disconnected youth in Westchester with recommendations for change.

2000s

- Secured the first-ever grant for Westchester's foster youth who age out of care to help them start their independent adult lives.
- Successfully advocated for increased public investments in early-childhood mental health, resulting in the creation of Early Step Forward programs that serve more than 1,000 children per year.
- Coordinated government and community agencies to enroll more than 10,000 eligible children in free or low-cost health insurance.
- Chaired the Child Health Advocacy Network (CHAN), a coalition of 70+ members (formerly Child Health Task Force).

1990s

- Founded the Campaign for Kids, in collaboration with the Westchester Council on Crime and Delinquency, successfully advocating for increased county investment in services for children and youth. The Campaign for Kids, led and staffed by WCA, now comprises of more than 80 organizations.
- Developed a supervised visitation program to enable children to maintain meaningful contact with non-custodial parents (now operated by YWCA of White Plains and Central Westchester with funding secured through WCA advocacy).
- Established the Yonkers Family Court Children's Center to care for young children whose parents had to appear as litigants (now operated by YWCA of Yonkers).

1914

-1980s

- A group of citizens starts Westchester Children's Association, underwriting the salaries of Westchester's first 6 child welfare workers.
- Led the movement to establish a Children's Court in Westchester, the first in New York State.
- Established a child guidance center in White Plains.
- Placed the first clinical psychologist in the county's public schools.
- Established an early childhood counseling center in Mt. Vernon, serving emotionally troubled preschool children and their parents. Westchester Children's Association turned responsibility for this center over to the county's Mental Health Board in 1975.

The Edith C. Macy Distinguished Service Award will recognize and honor an individual or group with an outstanding record of advocacy and accomplishments which have substantially benefitted children in Westchester.

With this award, WCA honors the memory of Edith Carpenter Macy, advocate, activist, and benefactor on behalf of children. For over two decades until her death in 1925, Edith C. Macy demonstrated pioneering philanthropic work and a great talent for networking and organizing which resulted in innovative programs, services and policy initiatives benefiting poor children in New York City and in Westchester County.

In 1914, the Children's Committee was incorporated as the Westchester Children's Association, and Mrs. Macy continued for years as its Vice President and dynamic leader. Edith Carpenter Macy remains today an inspiration to WCA members and other child advocates for her sustained dedication, leadership, hard work and generosity for the improvement of the lives of children, wherever they are.

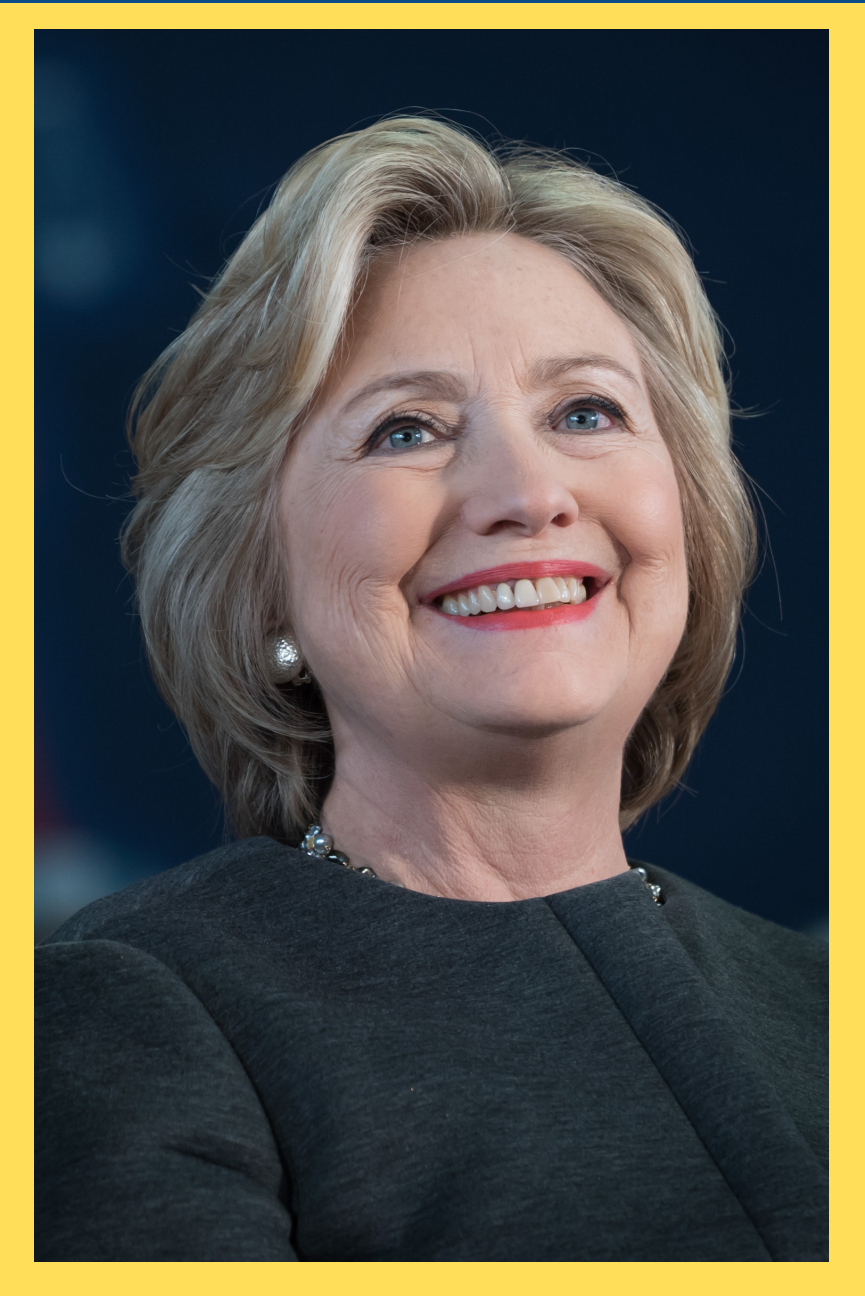

This year's Edith C. Macy Award for Distinguished Service, given in recognition of extraordinary contributions to children's well-being, will be awarded to Secretary Hillary Rodham Clinton. She was a leader in the fight to reform our nation's healthcare system by helping to create the Children's Health Insurance Program, which provides health coverage for more than 8 million children and has helped cut the uninsured rate for children in half.

Since its inception, GHV has excelled at widening a friendship circle to Dutchess, Putnam, Rockland, and Westchester counties.

The Westchester County (WC) (NY) Chapter of The Links, Incorporated engages in projects that impact the African American community and the African Diaspora. Today, the Westchester County (NY) Chapter of The Links, Incorporated supports youth through many programs. The L.I.F.E mentoring and NSBE Jr. programs support children in the Greenburgh Central School District. The Chapter's Young Achievers program helps students at New Rochelle High School. In addition to book drives, the WC (NY) Chapter of The Links programs encourages literacy and other initiatives in the name of service.



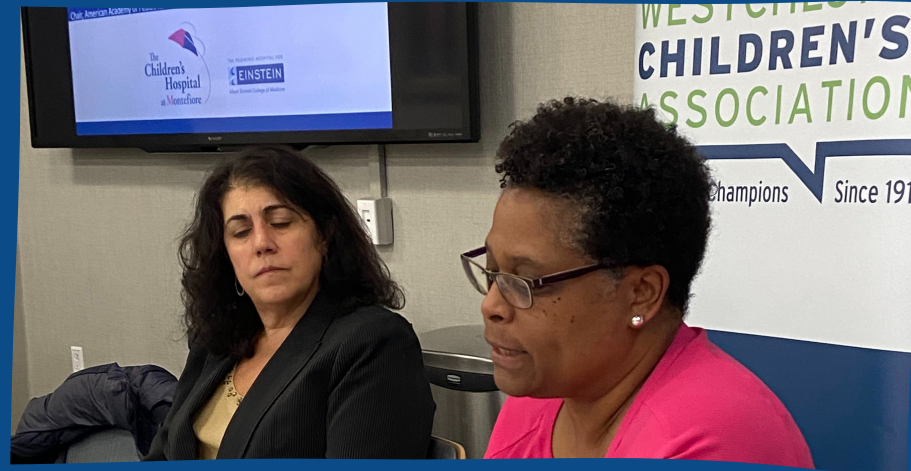
