WHO IS THE CAMPAIGN FOR KIDS COALITION?

The Campaign for Kids (CFK) is a non-partisan coalition of nonprofits, advocates, service providers, and community members united by one common goal: to make Westchester a place where all children have the opportunity to succeed. Convened and supported by WCA, CFK works to raise awareness, influence policy, and drive investments in programs and services that benefit children and youth. Together, the coalition ensures that kids remain a top priority in county-level planning, funding, and decision-making.

RECENT CAMPAIGN VICTORIES

With the support of community partners, the CFK coalition has supported multiple wins including:

- Advocated for increased funding of the county's Invest in Kids grant, which supports youth after school programs and civic engagement initiatives across Westchester.
- Restored full funding for the Westchester Works Childcare Scholarship, which provides financial support to working families with children enrolled in childcare.
- Encouraged school-based and out of school mental health initiatives.
